

ECONOMIC IMPACT



Health centers save the U.S. healthcare system over \$28 billion annually.



This economic impact is felt most strongly in rural and under-resourced areas, bolstering quality of life.



lowa health centers have significant impact on their local economies.



A University of Chicago study of 13 states found health centers each year save Medicaid, on average, \$2,371 per person in total cost of care when compared to other providers.



Health centers are cost effective Medicaid providers, serving 16% of all Mediciad beneficiaries in lowa, but representing only 2% of the state of Iowa's total Medicaid expenditures.
